### Chapter 1 Logotype

The logotype is the brand's emblem. A unique combination of shapes, graphic design & specific colors makes it one of the foundations of the brand's core identity.

## Logotype & baseline

This is the standard logotype for **nift**.

It can be shown with or without its baseline.








The baseline is a core feature of the brand identity. Thus, it can be written separately, in one line, as shown here.

Forget about delivery.

#### Protection zone & minimal size

We have defined a protection zone around the **nift** letters, the length of the "n" letter. The zone shall remain empty.

The minimal reading size of the logotype is 20mm long | 40mm if the baseline is included.









### Chapter 2 Colors

A very pop, fresh, colorful universe:

- main colors are part of the core of the brand identity
- secondary colors are designed to fit with the main colors
- no other color should be used on NIFT communication media

## Colors Main colors

#### White

mainly used as a background color.

#### Plum & coral

the identity color duo.

#### Black

to be used on corporate media or as a running text typography - never in the logotype.

## Colors Secondary colors


3 secondary colors can be used next to the main colors. They shall never by used alone.


2 type of grey (25% & 50%) can be used for running text.



Main colors can all be associated together (cf. Figure 1). In the case of corporate communications, main colors should be used altogether.

Secondary colors can't be used alone. They must be associated with at least one of the main colors (cf. Figure 2).





Chapter 3
Colors & identity

### Colors & identity Standard version

Standard logotype consists of 2 colors. On a white background, "nift" is shown in plum and the "jump" is coral-colored. On colored backgrounds: "nift" is always white, as the "jump" color is associated with the background.









2 - "Jump" color is not respected





### Colors & identity

#### Brand architecture & combinations

Logotype can be shown in 3 color combinations:

- "nift" is always plum-colored
- the "jump" takes one of the complementary colors

Logotype can never consist of 2 secondary colors: it has to show at least one of the main colors (cf. color combinations).











- 1 "nift" in complementary color
- 2 Only complementary colors

On color backgrounds, "nift" is plum-colored; the "jump" is white.

Corporate communications

For corporate communications purposes, brand identity can become monochromatic.

# Corporate communications Monochromatic logotype

Monochromatic versions of the logotype shall be used only on corporate documents: expense accounts, annual reporting, and reports.

Monochromatic versions of the logotypes only exist in main colors.

In the case of technical constraints, this B&W logotype can be used.














